Review of last meeting minutes - motion to accept by April Parton, 2nd by Natalie Yeahquo

New Business presented -

- A. Election of Student Representative - Corbett Jones Jr, nominated by April Parton, voted in by members present. His term will run through May, 2018
- B. Student Test Data - attached to agenda packet.
- C. Native American students' scores compared to all students' scores. Data based on students who are self-identified as Native American.
- D. Expenditure Report - attached to agenda packet.

Since we were without the part-time teacher for approximately two months (Mr. Hudson resigned), the payroll money that was set aside for that period of time must be reallocated. Budget allocations were adjusted, updates to Indirect Costs, Professional Development Registration, and Instructional. Introduction of new Title VI part-time teacher, Jeremy Cunkle. Committee was in agreement with the proposed changes.

Title VI teachers have made arrangements for Tim Tingle, Choctaw author, to visit their respective schools in May. Visit cost (\$1,500) to come from Instructional portion of budget. Teachers will also purchase copies of his books to use in their classes and site libraries.

Additional funds could go towards purchasing materials for students to take home for practice over the summer.

Mrs. Greenwood is also looking to purchase replacement Native American items to go in the experience kits. The kits contain small items that represent a diverse group of Native American tribes, but the items are getting worn. Parents present indicated interest in reaching out to their respective tribal contacts to obtain items for these kits.

- E. Federal Update - Consultation

Every Student Succeeds Act - school will collaborate/consult with local tribal nations for federal programs in a school district as part of grant requirement. Present in meeting are **Chickasaw Department of Education representatives:** Danny Wells, Director, Division of Education; Ben White, Coordinator of STEP(State and Tribal Education Partnership) Program; Woodrow Wilson, Coordinator of NYCP (Native Youth Community Project) Grant; Lynn Chatfield, Director, Office of Supportive Programs.

- Title VI (Indian Education)
