GUIDELINES FOR DETERMINING AMOUNTS OF ASSISTANCE PER STUDENT

Educational Support Items:

(Income Based)

(Application for Education Assistance is required and must be signed by school official)

Athletic Shoes (Half the cost of shoes but not to exceed max amount) **\$45.00 Per Student**
Maximum

(Limited to those students enrolled in a School Sports Activity grades 7th-12th, one sport per semester)

PE Shoes (Due to limited funding, documentation must be provided with Request stating that shoes are a requirement by the school) **\$10.00Per Student**
Maximum

Extra Curricular Uniforms **\$25.00 Per Student**
Maximum

(FFA Jacket, Choir, Band, Speech/Debate Uniform)

School or Class Fees & Field Trip Dues **\$20.00 Per Student**
Maximum

(FHA, FFA, Shop, Choir, Band, Class, Tech)

(Listing student(s) & amount of fee is required)

Payment of maximum amount of fee will depend on Funding and number of students requiring assistance. If funding permits and a student is active in more than one school activity, assistance can be provided **more than once, but no more than twice.**

Activity Needs/Supplies **\$20.00 Per Student**

(Home Ec., Choir, Band or Shop Supplies)

SCHOOL SUPPLY EXPENDITURES:

1) School Supplies are purchase in Bulk

Effective August 1996, the Indian Education Committee are required to purchase school supplies in Bulk. This requires an added effort on the part of the JOM community and Parental involvement is a must, especially for large communities. IEC is requested to hold a meeting in July for the purpose of completing JOM Applications and approving expenditures for school supply purchases to ensure that students will have the supplies at the start of school. No reimbursements to parents for school supply purchases are made due to the fact that school supplies are bought in Bulk and because funding for school supply purchases are limited.

2)Only Basic School Supplies Provided

Since the JOM Program is only a Supplemental Program and the fact that we do have a reduction in funding, we are only required to provide the Basic School Supplies. Any additional supplies are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

3)School Supplies provided in August

Due to decrease in funding and limitations on school supply expenditures, the JOM Program provided school supplies only once; this is at the beginning of school – August. The only exception to this is if a committee has a balance in the school supply line item.
