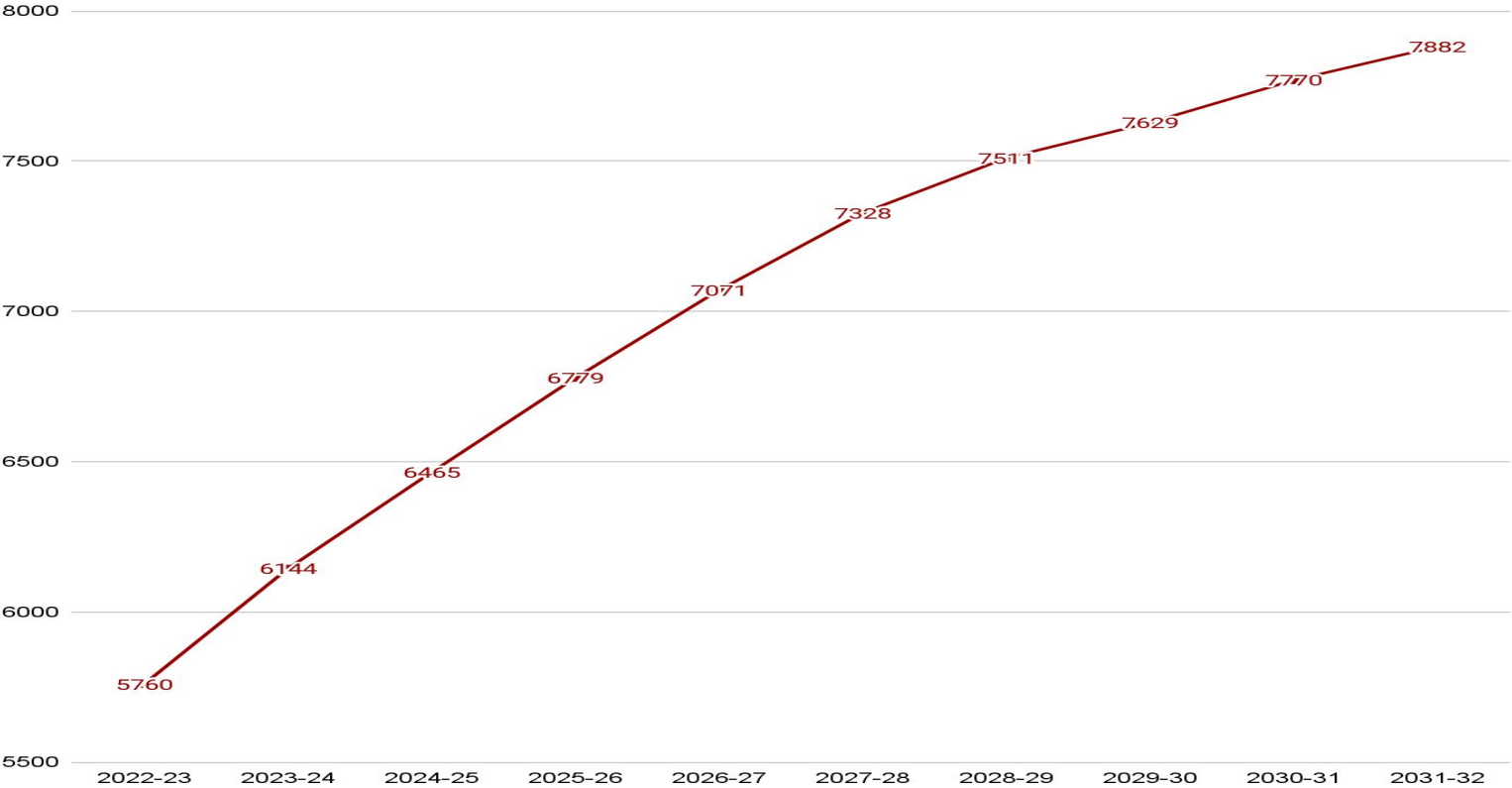

Concerns Given Riverwood Enrollment Projections

RW has grown by a total of 253 students (May 2022 - March 2023)

- ❑ Class Sizes: Kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade, & 4th grade will exceed class size limits.
 - This would require us to add 4 more teachers
 - We do not have any available space for additional classrooms
- ❑ GATE, Special Education, Speech, OT/PT, and reading specialists are all using spaces such as the conference room, closets, and media specialists office currently.
- ❑ When the 6 new classrooms open, we will need to use 4 of those rooms to place these teachers/service providers in appropriate spaces. The other two will be reserved for future growth at RW.
- ❑ Overcrowding in the Cafeteria

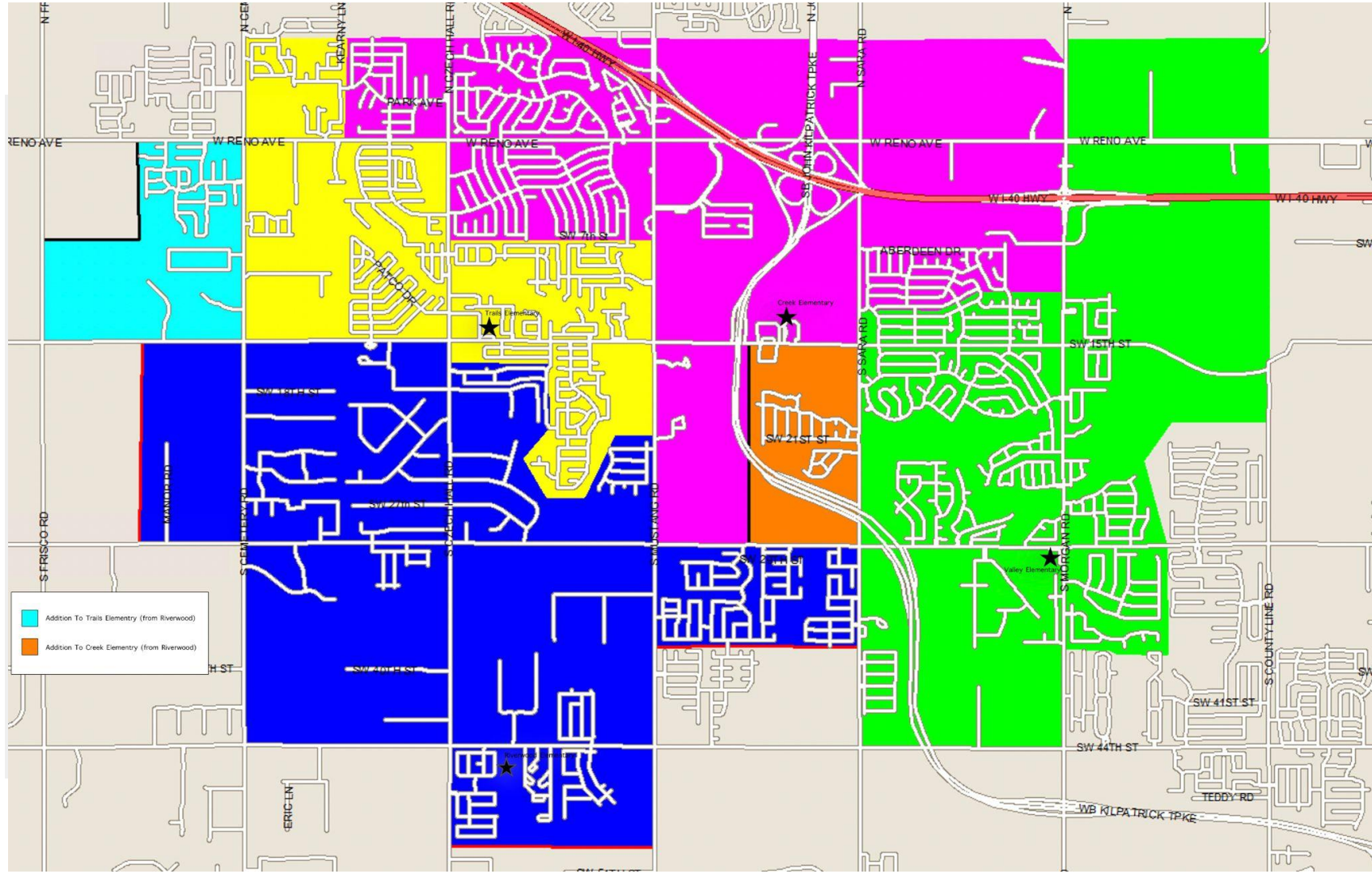


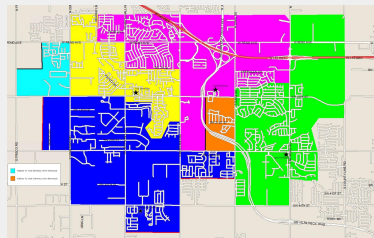


What's The Plan?

Realign the boundaries of Riverwood, Creek, & Trails elementary schools for 2023-24 to prepare for Elementary #9 and address growth.







The Plan

- One teaching position would move from Riverwood to Trails
- 115 students will be moved from RW to Trails
- 62 students will move from RW to Creek
- This will leave Riverwood with a new projected enrollment total of 731 students

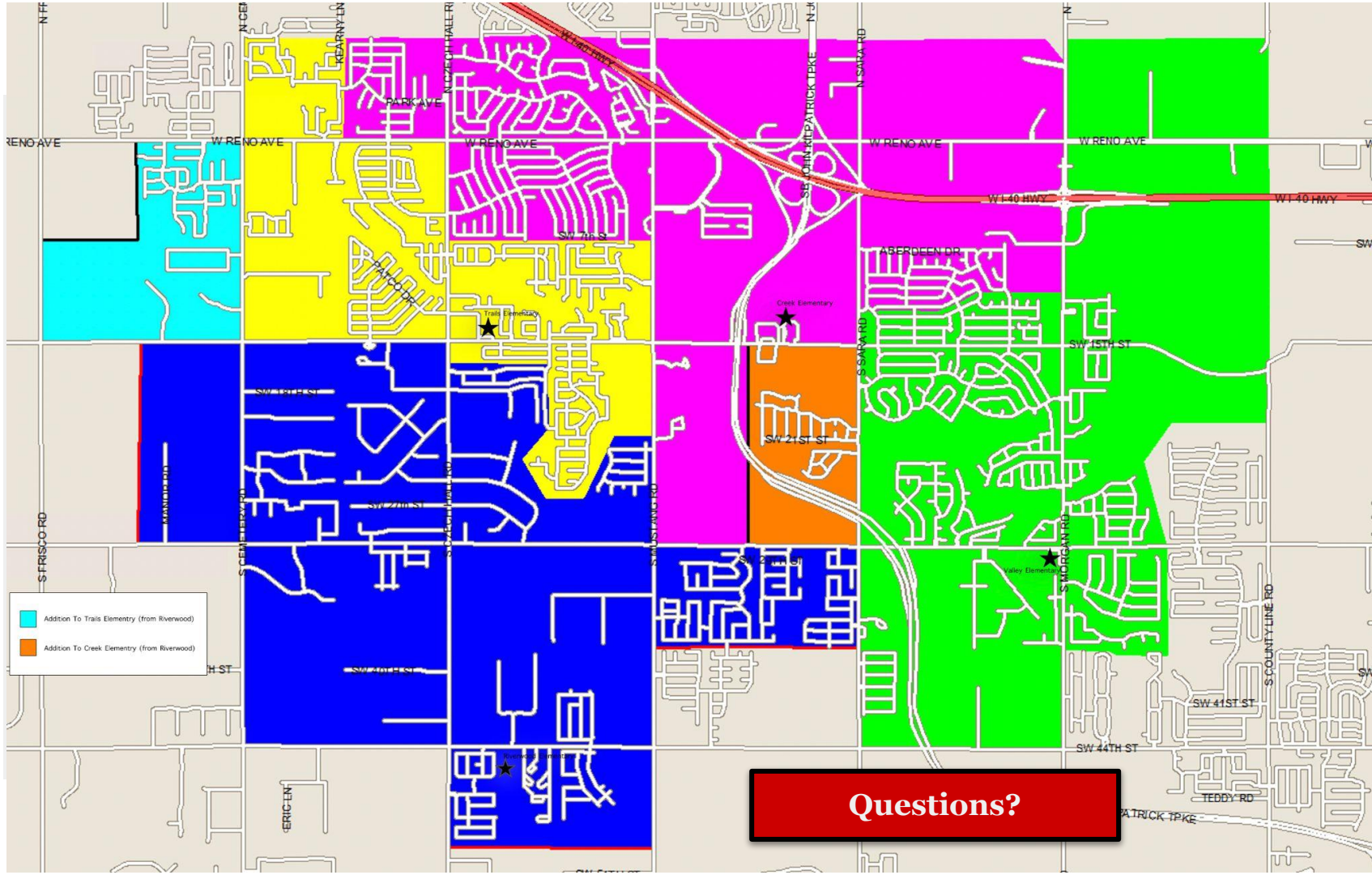

Transfer Information

- Parents of students who will be in a different elementary school boundary for 2023-2024 will receive a letter in the coming weeks confirming the move.
- Mustang Public Schools has a policy in place that will allow students who will be fourth graders next year to remain in their current school for their "exit year."
 - Parents must fill out a transfer form and turn it in at their current elementary school.
 - Once the form is received, the transfer for exit year students will be automatically approved.
 - Parents can also fill out a transfer form for younger students if they would like for them to remain at their original school, but approval of those transfers is based on enrollment.
 - **Transportation must be provided by the parents for any transfers.**
